The TRUTH youdiscovertruth lives by, guards and is not ashamed of:

THE Bible is the Living Word of God; both the Old and New Testaments, is infallible and inerrant in the original writings and is the supreme and final authority for faith, salvation, and life.

THE GODHEAD; exists in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. These three Persons are one God having the same nature, attributes, and perfections.

JESUS CHRIST is LORD; the deity of Jesus:

- Jesus' eternal existence as God,
- Jesus' Incarnation and Virgin Birth,
- Jesus' death on the cross accomplished redemption from sin,
- Jesus' literal, bodily resurrection from the dead,
- Jesus' present ministry of intercession in heaven, and
- Jesus' future return to earth.

SALVATION;
