### WHEN?

<sup>7</sup> In the first month, (🕒 *Here's a time phrase*)

Which is WHEN? (🕒 *We know specifically when*)  
which is the month Nisan,

WHEN? (🕒 *We know specifically when*)  
in the twelfth year of King Ahasuerus,

### WHAT?

Pur, that is the lot,

WHAT?  
was cast

before WHO?  
before Haman

WHEN?  
from day to day (🕒 *Timing is given*)

and

WHEN?  
from month *to month*, (🕒 *Timing is given*)

until WHEN  
until the twelfth month, (🕒 *Timing is given*)

that is WHAT  
that is the month Adar. (🕒 *Timing is given*)

Then WHO?

<sup>8</sup> Then Haman

WHAT?  
said to King Ahasuerus,

There is WHO?  
"There is a certain people

that are WHAT?  
scattered

and

WHAT else?  
dispersed

WHERE?  
among the peoples in all the provinces of your kingdom;

WHO WHAT?  
their laws are different from *those* of all *other* people

and

WHO WHAT?  
they do not observe the king's laws,

so WHAT?  
so it is not in the king's interest to let them remain.

WHAT does Haman suggest?

let it be decreed that they be destroyed,

WHO?(Haman)WHAT?  
I will pay

WHAT?  
ten thousand talents of silver

WHERE?  
into the hands

of WHO?  
of those who carry on the *king's* business,

WHY?  
to put into the king's treasuries."

Then WHO?

WHAT?

and took his signet ring from his hand

WHAT?  
gave it

to WHO?  
to Haman,

WHO is he?  
the son of Hammedatha the Agagite,

the WHAT?  
the enemy of the Jews.

<sup>11</sup> The king

WHAT? WHO?  
said to Haman,

WHAT?  
“The silver

is WHAT?  
is yours,

and WHAT else? WHO?  
the people *also*,

WHAT?  
to do with them as you please.”
