Then WHO?

⁹ Then Haman

WHAT?

went out (*Out from where?*)

WHEN?

that day (See the  *Time Phrase*)

HOW?

glad

and

HOW?

pleased of heart;

but ( 'but' indicates a *contrast*, what is being *contrasted*?)

WHAT happened?

WHEN WHO?

when Haman

WHAT?

saw

WHO?

Mordecai

WHERE?

in the king's gate

and

WHO?

that he (*Mordecai*)

WHAT?

did not stand up

or

WHAT?

tremble before him,

WHAT happened?

WHO?

Haman

WHAT?

was filled with anger

against WHO?

against Mordecai.

WHO?

¹⁰ Haman

WHAT?

controlled himself,

however, ( LOOK for the *Contrast*)

WHAT?

went to his house

and

WHAT?

sent for

WHO?

his friends

and

WHO else?

his wife Zeresh.

Then WHO?

¹¹ Then Haman

WHAT?

recounted

To WHO?

to them (*Them who? His friends/wife*)

WHAT?

the glory of his riches,

and

WHAT?

the number of his sons,

and

WHAT?
every *instance*

where WHO?
where the king

WHAT?
had magnified him

and

WHAT?
how he (*He who? The king*)

WHAT?
had promoted him (*Him who? Haman*)

HOW? WHERE?
above

WHO?
the princes
and
WHO?
servants of the
king.

WHO?
¹² Haman

WHAT?
also said,

Even WHO?
“Even Esther the queen

WHAT?
let no one

but (☐ *What is being contrasted?*)

WHO?
me

WHAT?

come with the king

To WHERE?

to the banquet which she had prepared;

and

WHEN?

tomorrow also (See the  Time Phrase)

WHAT?

I am invited

By WHO?

by her with the king.

¹³ Yet ( What is being *Contrasted*?)

WHAT?

all of this

WHAT?

does not satisfy me

WHEN?

every time I see

WHO?

Mordecai the Jew

WHAT?

sitting at the king's gate."

Then WHO?

¹⁴ Then Zeresh his wife

and

WHO?

all his friends

WHAT?

said to him,

WHAT?

"Have a gallows fifty cubits high made

and

WHEN?

in the morning (See the  Time Phrase)

WHAT?

ask the king

WHAT?

to have Mordecai

WHAT?

hanged on it;

Then WHAT?

then go

HOW?

joyfully

with WHO?

with the king

to WHERE?

to the banquet.”

And

WHAT?

the advice

WHAT?

pleased Haman,

So WHAT did he (*Haman*) do?

so he had the gallows made.
