## WHAT?

that are WHAT?

and

they were WHAT?

they were read before the king.

## WHAT?

what Mordecai had reported

concerning WHO?

concerning Bigthana

and

Teresh,

WHO were WHAT?

two of the king's eunuchs

WHO were WHAT?

who were doorkeepers,

WHAT had they done?

that they had sought to lay hands

on WHO?

on King Ahasuerus.

WHO? WHAT?

<sup>3</sup>The king said,

WHAT?

“What honor

or

WHAT?

dignity

has WHAT?

has been bestowed

on WHO?

on Mordecai

for WHAT?

for this?”

Then WHO?

Then the king’s servants

who WHAT?

who attended him

said WHAT?

said, “Nothing has been done for him.”

So WHO?

said WHAT?

said, “Who is in the court?”

And

WHO?

the king

said WHAT?  
said, "Let him come in."

WHO?  
Now Haman

WHAT?  
had just entered

entered WHERE?  
the outer court  
of WHAT?  
of the king's palace

entered WHY?  
in order to speak

to WHO?  
to the king

speak about WHAT?  
about hanging Mordecai on the gallows

which he WHAT?  
which he had prepared  
for him. (*Mordecai*)

WHO?  
<sup>5</sup>The king's servants

said to WHO?  
said to him, (*the king*)

said WHAT?  
"Behold, Haman is standing in the court."

And

WHO?  
the king

said WHAT?  
said, "Let him come in."

So WHO?

<sup>6</sup>So Haman

WHAT?

came in

and

WHO?

the king

said to WHO?

said to him, (*Haman*)

WHAT?

“What is to be done for the man

WHOM WHAT?

whom the king desires to honor?”

And

WHO?

Haman

said to WHO?

said to himself,

said WHAT?

“Whom would the king

WHAT?

desire to honor more than

WHO?

me?”

Then WHO?

<sup>7</sup>Then Haman

said to WHO?

said to the king,

said WHAT?

“For the man whom the king desires to honor,

WHO?

<sup>8</sup>let them

bring WHAT?  
bring a royal robe

specifically WHAT robe?  
which the king has worn,

and

WHAT else?  
the horse

specifically WHAT horse?  
on which the king has ridden,

and

WHAT else?  
on whose head (*the king's*)

WHAT?  
a royal crown has been placed;

<sup>9</sup>and

let WHAT?  
let the robe

and

WHAT else?  
the horse

WHAT?  
be handed over

to WHO?  
to one of the king's most noble princes

and

let WHO?  
let them (*the most noble princes*)

WHAT?  
array the man whom the king desires to  
honor

and

WHAT?

lead him on horseback

WHERE?

through the city square,

and

WHAT else?

proclaim

before WHO?

before him, (*the man honored*)

proclaim WHAT?

‘Thus it shall be done to the man  
whom the king desires to honor.’”
