Then WHO?
Then the king

WHAT?
said

to WHO?
to Haman,

WHAT?
“Take quickly the robes
and

WHAT else?
the horse

as WHAT?
as you (Haman) have said,

and
WHAT else?
do so

for WHO?
for Mordecai

the WHAT?
the Jew,

who is WHERE?
who is sitting at the king’s gate;

do not fall short

in WHAT?
in anything of all that you have said.”

So WHO?
¹¹ So Haman

WHAT?
took the robe

and

WHAT else?
the horse,

and

WHAT?
arrayed Mordecai,

and

WHAT?
led him *on horseback*

WHERE?
through the city square,

and

WHAT?
proclaimed

before WHO?
before him, (*Mordecai*)

WHAT?
“Thus it shall be done to

WHO?
the man whom the king

WHAT?
desires to honor.”

Then WHO?
¹² Then Mordecai

WHAT?
returned

WHERE?
to the king’s gate.

But

WHO?
Haman

WHAT?

hurried home,

HOW?

mourning, with *his* head covered.



What is the Contrast?

WHO?

¹³ Haman

WHAT?

recounted

to WHO?

to Zeresh his wife

and

to WHO?

all his friends

WHAT?

everything that had happened to him.

Then WHO?

Then his wise men

and

WHO?

Zeresh his wife

said to WHO?

said to him, (*Haman*)

said WHAT?

“If Mordecai,

WHAT?

before whom

WHO?

you (*Haman*)

WHAT?

have begun to fall,

is WHAT?

is of Jewish origin,

WHO?

you (*Haman*)

WHAT?

will not overcome him,

but

WHAT?

will surely fall before him.”

were still talking with him, (*Haman*)

WHO?

the king's eunuchs

WHAT?

arrived

and

WHAT?

hastily brought Haman

WHERE?

to the banquet

which WHO?

which Esther

had

prepared.
